

Introduction

The subject of Law was introduced for the first time at BA level in the year 2004 under the Political Science Department. Later on, considering the significance of the subject the separate Department of Law was established under the supervision of Prof. Muhammad Khalid Pervaiz, Dean, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. The course of Law, being an allied subject, focuses on inculcating legal knowledge and norms prevalent in the country to the students of GCU. Law is a foundation course for students who wish to take the subject as a full time option later on during the course of their studies. It also includes updated information regarding developed legal systems and the legal system of Pakistan as it exists today.
