

- b. For applicants with BSc as the highest qualification:

BSc	35%
Intermediate or equivalent exam including Hafiz-e-Quran marks	35%
Entry Test Marks	30%

- c. For applicants having Diploma of Associate Engineer as the highest qualification

Diploma of Associate Engineer including Hafiz-e-Quran marks	70%
Entry Test Marks	30%

- d. For applicants having B Tech. (Pass) as the highest qualification

B Tech. (Pass)	35%
Diploma of Associate Engineer including Hafiz-e-Quran marks	35%
Entry Test Marks	30%

Determination of Merit in Case of Equal Composite Score

If two or more applicants have equal composite score (rounded to 3 decimal places), they shall be treated at par for the purpose of admission. In case there is a tie for the last seat, then all the candidates who have secured equal composite scores shall be granted admission. However, no transfer or new entry shall be considered unless the actual number of candidates already admitted falls below the number of seats allocated for that discipline/category.

BCom

Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant (Male/Female) applying for admission to BCom 4-years (Hons) programme must have passed his/her HSSC (Pre-Engineering, Pre-Medical, ICS, Gen. Science, ICom and DCom) with at least 50% marks or A-level / I2 Grade or equivalent in three subjects in first annual examination of the year of admission or in the preceding year of the admission.
- The maximum age limit for an applicant seeking admission to BCom (Hons) is twenty two years on the last date for submission of application.
- Admission will be strictly on merit which shall be determined on the basis of overall marks, test and interview.

MBA

Eligibility Criteria

- Admission shall be open to both male and female candidates.
- The Applicants must have 16 years of education and must have 50% marks.
- The applicant must also take either the GMAT or the GCUMAT conducted by the MSD. Those who pass the test will be called for panel interview.

Selection Criteria

- Weighted average will be 20%
- Candidates having Master's/Bachelor's 4-Year Degree will be given 15 marks for obtaining 50% marks/2.00 CGPA (on a scale of 4.00), and 20 marks for obtaining 1st Division/60% marks/3.00 CGPA (on a scale of 4.00).
- Candidates having Bachelor's (3-Year) Degree will be given 10 marks for obtaining 1st Division.
